***B. DEAR***


The on-line DEAR is now current with all changes from finalized rulemakings. We added a rulemaking summary to the Table of Contents to highlight the parts of DEAR that were changed by each rule. We also added a link to allow users to go directly to the Federal Register to read the published rulemaking, which includes background information and the rationale for the DEAR changes.

***C. Acquisition Letters***

We updated the listing to remove all expired Acquisition Letters [AL]. Additionally, we added past years' annual listings which provide historical information on dates of previously canceled or discontinued ALs.

***D. DOE Acquisition Guide***

The on-line Acquisition Guide is current and includes a more detailed Table of Contents which identifies specific sections within Guide Chapters. The Guide may be downloaded and printed in the original Word Perfect files. (*Note: During FY 2000, the Acquisition Guide will be completely re-published in hard copy and distributed throughout the Department.*)
